First introduced in South Africa in 2007, the Captiva is a highly capable seven seater with an appealing design that has seen more than 16 400 units sold locally. The Captiva offers a smooth ride over any condition the South African landscape can throw at it. The spacious cabin allows for extra storage space and has three rows of seats with high levels of safety and comfort.

The first noticeable change on the 2016 Captiva is the front double grille which is smaller and the Chevrolet badge is now smack-bang in the middle. The front appearance has a more square look with narrower headlights and new spots. The headlamps incorporate LED day time running lights and are now automatic.

Comfort abounds for all and the Captiva comes with a long list of standard features which include: an on-board computer; Eight-way electronically adjustable driver's seat; Dual zone climate control; MyLink 2.0 with large touchscreen ; Rear park assist; Cruise Control; Keyless Entry and Keyless Start (PEPS); Hill Descent Control and Hill Start Assist; Power folding mirrors.
